STEP 1: UNPACK

Remove the cover from the storage bag. Avoid contact with the floor where possible to avoid the inner lining of the cover coming in contact with dirt and grit before being fitted.



STEP 2: UNROLL

Place the rolled up cover onto the car. We suggest starting from the front of the vehicle and rolling the cover out to the rear of the car. For cars with rear fins, start the process from the rear.



STEP 3: POSITION

Position the cover centrally to the car and ensure the mirror pockets are in-line with the mirrors. If not, rotate the cover around. Avoid contact with the floor if possible.



STEP 4: MIRRORS

Open out the cover to locate the mirror pockets. Take hold of the pockets and pull down over the door mirrors. Repeat for other mirror pocket. Please note that all our covers are designed to accommodate the wing mirrors when out.

STEP 5: FRONT

With the cover now secured by the mirror pockets, pull down the front of the cover over the bonnet and underneath the bodywork.



STEP 6: REAR

Repeat for the rear of car. Adjust the cover where necessary as you go until the cover is in position.



STEP 7: FASTEN

All outdoor covers come with securing straps. Clip the strap into the connector on one side and pass the strap under the car to the other side. Connect other buckle to connector. Repeat for all straps.



STEP 8: FINISH

Once again, go around the cover and adjust where necessary. Gently tighten strapping if needed. Your cover is now fitted. To remove the cover simply reverse this process and return to storage bag.

COVER CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Our tailored outdoor covers can deliver years of valuable protection for your car. To maximise the benefits from your cover always remember to adhere to the following:

ONLY COVER A CLEAN CAR

It is advised that the cover is placed on a clean car whenever possible as dirt, dust and grit could cause scratching.

KEEP COVER OFF THE GROUND

To prevent dirt and grit from potentially coming between the cover and the paintwork, do not allow the inside of the cover to touch the ground.

CLEANING GUIDANCE

We advise, for best results and for the long term benefit of the product, that you use a damp cloth in warm water. See label on the cover for instructions. Allow to dry naturally.

DO NOT CLEAN IN ANY WASHING MACHINE
OR DRY CLEAN.

IT'S LEAKING! LOOK, THERE IS WATER UNDER THE COVER?

Relax... The cover isn't leaking and this is perfectly normal. The water underneath is dew. This is water vapour that condenses to form droplets as the temperature falls. Later, when the sun warms the air, the dew evaporates. Overnight, anything exposed to the open air will become wet as, by then, the air is saturated with water. It's a normal, though not always welcome, phenomenon.

Most covers are designed to protect against rain, dirt and abrasion, but if they are not breathable and don't let moisture escape through the fabric, water droplets remain trapped between the cover and the bodywork and over time this could become a problem. Our car cover fabric is made with a special Moisture Vapour Permeable (MVP) membrane that, together with the other layers, protects your car from rain, dirt and abrasion. Micropores in the fabric allow the cover to breathe and water vapour to escape.

Your car may not always be dry in the morning, but it will dry throughout the day as the moisture evaporates through the micropores in the fabric.
