STORAGE COVER FABRIC FEATURES

Your guide to the important fabric qualities you should consider when purchasing a caravan or motorhome cover.

WATERPROOF

To ascertain the level of water penetration in any material, you need to check its Hydrostatic Head Rating. According to Go Outdoors' guide to waterproofing, the definition of waterproof is 1500mm hydrostatic head. This means that a column of water up to 1500mm can sit on the fabric before any water ingress. Our storage cover fabric can withstand 2500mm and greater. Understanding the hydrostatic head will help you choose whether or not your cover will protect your caravan or motorhome from rain downpours and heavy snow. We want to protect your caravan as much as possible.

BREATHABILITY

A breathable membrane allows vapour to escape through the fabric to ensure that you don't have any sweating underneath the cover. However, no fabric in the world can magically make moisture turn into vapour without a heat source, which means that on a car, caravan or motorhome, it must wait for natural heat to allow it to change to vapour. The speed at which it can escape is of no consequence once moisture has turned to vapour. We place importance on breathability but not at the cost of the other aspects required, which is why our fabric provides every important feature of what's required in a cover.

TAILORED MATERIAL

STRENGTH

We all know how much damage adverse weather can cause. When choosing a caravan or motorhome cover you should choose one that has good ratings of the following: Tensile Strength (BS EN 12311-1), Elongation (BS EN 12311-1) and Resistance to Tearing (BS EN 12310-1). Our fabric has been tested to the British and European Standards so you can be confident in our material's ability to withstand the elements. We have chosen a material that is strong without compromising on its waterproof, breathable or weight requirements. We also ensure seams are kept to a minimum to maintain these properties. The more seams you have, the more weak points your cover has.

NON ABRASIVE INNER LINING

It would be pointless to go to all this effort to find the right material to protect your caravan or motorhome only to discover that the material itself damages the vehicle. Under no circumstances would we develop a product that would compromise your pride and joy and leave it scratching your paintwork. Our caravan and motorhome material has been developed with the same technology as that within a baby's nappy, ensuring no scratches will be left on your caravan or motorhome as long as you have ensured it's clean before the cover goes on.


